Thanks for your interest in becoming a contestant in Utica High School's "Mr. Chieftain" contest. Here is what is expected of you:

1. Your first commitment will be to attend a mandatory meeting on Tuesday, March 7, at 2:15p.m., in Room 240. At this BRIEF meeting you will receive more details about the event. At this meeting you'll receive a collection jar. Your goal is to advertise yourself and collect as much money as possible for the *Macomb Charitable Foundation*. These jars will be collected at the end of the day in the student activities office on Tuesday, March 21st. The contestants who raise the most money for this charity will be crowned *Mr. Charity*.
2. If you are successful in making it to the final round, you are responsible for finding a girl to be your "coach" as you attempt to prepare yourself to be *Mr. Chieftain*. (Your coach must be approved by Mrs. Rajewski or Mrs. Yucha.)
3. There will be mandatory rehearsals on March 15th (cafeteria), March 16 (cafeteria) after school, and a final run through in the auditorium at a date to be determined. At this time you will be required to learn a short choreographed routine that will be performed as the opening act in the final show.
4. Each contestant must participate in an interview that will be aired during the final show.
5. March 23rd is the final show. During the show you will be required to participate in 3 separate challenges. A panel of teachers/ UHS staff will judge your performance.
6. Although this is going to be a very fun event, your dress and conduct must still comply with the UCS guidelines. Students not taking the event seriously may be removed from participating in this event at any time, at the discretion of the Activities Director.
